AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 2 3 YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 7 8 maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 10 June 30, 2006..... \$ 10,579,916.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 14 15 Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the 16 purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal 17 18 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 19\$ 2,888,926.00. 20 SECTION 3. 45	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			

46 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 47 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 48 49 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 51 52 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 53 54 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 56 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 57 58 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 59 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 60 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this *HR05/A245* H. 05/HR05/A245 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) 61 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 62 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 63 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 64 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 65 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

66 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 67 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 69 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 70 The 71 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 72 73 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 74 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March and June 30.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 83 84 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 85 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 86 87 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 88 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 89 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 90 91 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 92 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

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93 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 94 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the 95 96 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 97 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972. 98 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 99 100 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 101 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 123 124 Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 125 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed *HR05/A245* H. B. No. 1648

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126 Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 127 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 128 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.

132 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 133 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 134 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 135 136 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 137 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 138 139 and after July 1, 2005.
