77	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
78	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
79	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006

112 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 113 114 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 115 116 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 117 118 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 119 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 120

147	SECTION 9. None of the funds provided for in this act shall
148	be used to pay the salary of any employee who does not report to
149	the Director of the Division of Medicaid or one of his
150	subordinates.
151	SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
152	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
153	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
154	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
155	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
156	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
157	SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from
158	and after July 1, 2005.
