AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2 3 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 9 .....\$ 26,794,035.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 14 15 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year 16 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 17 18 .....\$ 204,923,129.00. SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 19 20 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 21 Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board of Health for 22 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006. 23 \$ 12,562,607.00. 24 The above funds shall be allocated as follows: 25 26 Maternal and Child Health Care Program.....\$1,242,943.00 27

33 The State Department of Health may transfer a portion of 34 Trauma Care System funds to the Division of Medicaid for the 35 development and implementation of an enhanced reimbursement fee 36 program related to trauma care and services, used to match federal 37 funds, under a cooperative agreement between the State Department 38 of Health and the Division of Medicaid.

It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the Five 39 40 Million Three Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Nine Hundred One Dollars (\$5,326,901.00) authorized herein for the Trauma Care System shall 41 be expended to the benefit of any hospital located outside the 42 boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless otherwise excepted 43 in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise excepted in this 44 45 paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to receive such funds until such time as the amount appropriated for 46 such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight Million Dollars 47 (\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the 48 49 Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the Regional 50 Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for 51 their participation in the Trauma Care System.

52 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 53 Sections 1, 2 and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below 54 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 55 expenditure:

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94 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 95 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 96 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 97 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

98 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 99 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 100 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 101 102 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 103 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 104 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 105 106 appropriated level.

107 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 108 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 109 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 110 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

111 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Department of Health shall maintain complete accounting and 112 113 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 114 115 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 116 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 117 118 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 119 120 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,

SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 159 160 Mississippi Department of Health shall have authority to escalate 161 the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval 162 of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds collected or 163 available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year, 164 not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), to the agency 165 for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Mississippi Department of Health may expend such funds in the manner authorized by law. 166

167 The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of 168 Health shall submit to the Department of Finance and 169 Administration a certified statement providing a detailed explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the 170 171 establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing positions and the existence of any required matching funds for 172 those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's 173 General Fund Budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the 174 175 fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.

176 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with 177 the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may 178 provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to 179 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such 180 vaccinations through job related exposure.

SECTION 9. In addition to all other sums heretofore 181 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 182 183 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water 184 185 Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in 186 Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for 187 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and 188 189 Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year 190 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....

Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of 193 194 Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate 195 special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. These 196 funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no 197 later than July 31, 2005. The State Department of Health shall make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 198 Department of Human Services. 199

200 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 201 State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty 202 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 203 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as 204 "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder 205 adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 206 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder 207 adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 208 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed 209 pathology and biannual MRI exams.

SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore 210 211 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 212 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in 213 the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State 214 of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery 215 216 Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning 217 218 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 5,000,000.00. It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds 219 appropriated in this section, an amount not less than Two Million 220 221 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund 222 the School Tobacco Nurse Program.

SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) are provided for the

SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be provided to the Southern AIDS Commission, Inc. for the purpose of providing technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery services to persons infected with HIV.

SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the amounts of One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the T. K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program.

SECTION 16. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical Cancer Program.

SECTION 17. In addition to all other funds heretofore 243 244 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 245 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 246 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department 247 of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 248 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of 249 funding the Federal Bioterrorism Preparedness Program to the State 250 Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, 251 and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 14,280,000.00.

SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
