AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; AND FOR 2 3 RELATED PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 7 8 maintenance of the Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 9 7,942,069.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Environmental Quality which is comprised of special source funds 14 15 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the support of the various offices of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 17 18\$ 124,676,346.00. 19 SECTION 3. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 53 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 55 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 58 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" *HR05/A470* H. 05/HR05/A470 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 Unless expressly authorized herein by the Legislature, no funds appropriated shall be expended to pay expenses incurred by 79 80 more than four (4) employees or other representatives of the 81 agency for attending the same conference, seminar or workshop, 82 either in-state or out-of-state; however, such funds may be expended for expenses incurred by more than four (4) employees or 83 84 other representatives for attendance at the same conference, 85 seminar or workshop (a) if attendance is required in order to maintain professional certification or licensure, which 86 87 certification or licensure is required by the employees' job 88 descriptions or by law, or (b) if such expenditure has received the prior written approval of the Department of Finance and 89 Administration. 90

91 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 Department of Environmental Quality shall maintain complete 93 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all H. B. No. 1659 *HR05/A470* 05/HR05/A470

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94 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 95 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 96 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 97 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 98 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 99 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 100 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2007.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 138 139 Department of Environmental Quality shall have authority to 140 escalate the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds 141 142 collected or available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year, not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), 143 144 to the agency for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Department of Environmental Quality may expend such funds in the manner 145 146 authorized by law.

147 The Executive Director of the Department of Environmental 148 Quality shall submit to the Department of Finance and Administration a certified statement providing a detailed 149 explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the 150 151 establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing positions and the existence of any required matching funds for 152 153 those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's general fund budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the 154 fiscal year in which the escalation is requested. 155

SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for H. B. No. 1659 *HRO5/A470* 05/HR05/A470 PAGE 5 (RM\ST) 160 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 161 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

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It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 163 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 164 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. 165 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and allocated in Section 3, an amount no greater than Three Hundred 166 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$320,000.00) shall be derived from the 167 168 Pollution Emergency Fund within the Pollution Operating Fund and 169 shall be transferred to the Department of Finance and 170 Administration.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and 171 172 allocated in Section 3, an amount no greater than One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be derived from the 173 Pollution Emergency Fund within the Pollution Operating Fund for 174 transfer to the Department of Environmental Quality - Office of 175 176 Administrative Services for support of Legal Division 177 environmental protection activities.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and 178 179 allocated in Section 3, an amount no greater than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be derived from the Pollution Emergency 180 181 Fund within the Pollution Operating Fund for transfer to the Department of Environmental Quality - Office of Pollution Control 182 183 for support of the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Grants 184 Program.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 185 186 Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality may 187 authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 188 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 189 190 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 191 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be

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192 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 193 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 194 195 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 196 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 197 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 198 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 199 200 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 201 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 202 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 203 204 Mississippi State Legislature."

205 SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 206 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 207 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 208 209 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 210 211 SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 212
