AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE FOR THE 2 3 FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 6 7 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 8 Department of Insurance which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the 9 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 10 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 11 12\$ 6,744,501.00. 13 SECTION 2. 33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 36 37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 39 40 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 act. 44 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 46 47 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 49 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 53 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

55 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 56 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 57 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 58 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 59 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 60 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 61 HR05/A501*

05/HR05/A501 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) 61 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 62 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 63 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 Mississippi Department of Insurance shall maintain complete 69 70 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 71 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 72 73 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 74 75 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 76 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 77 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

78 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 79 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, Sixteen 80 Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-one Dollars (\$16,451.00) is provided 81 for the Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and 82 Certification Board.

SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 83 84 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 85 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck 86 Acquisition Fund to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for 87 the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the fiscal 88 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 89\$ 1,700,000.00. SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 90 91 Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, funds in

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 95 96 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 97 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 98 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 99 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 100 101 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 102 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 103 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 104 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 105 Mississippi State Legislature."

106 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 107 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 109 110 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 111 112 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 113
