## HOUSE BILL NO. 1700

1	AN AGE TO AUTHORITE THE COMPRISE AUTHORITE OF THE CITY OF
1	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF
2	LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE HUMANE SOCIETY
3	OF SOUTH MISSISSIPPI, TO PURCHASE LAND TO CONSTRUCT AN ANIMAL
4	SHELTER AND FACILITIES TO CARRY OUT THE SOCIETY'S FUNCTIONS AND
5	PUBLIC SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** The governing authorities of the City of Long
- 8 Beach, Mississippi, in their discretion, may contribute to the
- 9 capital building fund of the Humane Society of South Mississippi,
- 10 a not-for-profit corporation, for the acquisition of land in Long
- 11 Beach, Mississippi, and construction thereon of modern and
- 12 expansive facilities to house its animal shelter to receive and
- 13 care for stray, lost and unclaimed animals in a humane way, and to
- 14 carry out all of the Humane Society's needed functions and public
- 15 services.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
