HOUSE BILL NO. 1767 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 1 2. TO DO ANY AND ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE AND IMPROVE WATER OR 3 SEWER SERVICES TO JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize and 6
- 7 empower the Jackson County Board of Supervisors to help provide
- and enhance water and sewer services to Jackson County, 8
- 9 Mississippi.
- SECTION 2. Jackson County, Mississippi, may help construct, 10
- acquire, improve, extend and maintain water and/or sewer lines 11
- anywhere within the county for the purpose of enhancing or 12
- assisting in the provision of water, through existing water and 13
- sewer districts, to the residents or businesses within Jackson 14
- County. In addition, Jackson County, Mississippi, by and through 15
- 16 the Jackson County Port Authority, shall in its discretion have
- authority and may wholesale water to any public or private entity. 17
- SECTION 3. This act shall serve as authority for any private 18
- 19 and/or public entity to cooperate with and/or contract with
- 20 Jackson County in furtherance of the purposes set out in this act.
- 21 This act shall further serve as authorization for Jackson County
- for the purposes of obtaining either state or federal funds, and 22
- 23 to execute legal certifications necessary to comply with any state
- or federal funding requirements so long as any systems constructed 24
- with such funds comply with Sections 1 and 2 of this act. 25
- 26 SECTION 4. Jackson County, Mississippi, is authorized to do
- 2.7 all acts necessary and proper or convenient in the exercise of the
- 28 powers granted under this act, and such act shall be liberally

- 29 construed for the purposes set out in the act, and the powers
- 30 granted being independent from any power granted to Jackson County
- 31 or any municipality or district within the county by any general
- 32 or local and private act of the Legislature.
- 33 **SECTION 5.** The authority granted under this act shall not be
- 34 construed as authority for the Board of Superviosrs of Jackson
- 35 County, Mississippi, to create a countywide utility district. The
- 36 creation of such a utility district is strictly prohibited under
- 37 this act.
- 38 **SECTION 6.** If any provision of this act shall be held to be
- 39 invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder
- 40 shall not be affected thereby.
- 41 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after its passage.
