HOUSE BILL NO. 1776

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MONROE
2 COUNTY, THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF AMORY AND THE
3 GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN TO CONSTRUCT A
4 BUILDING AT THE MONROE COUNTY AIRPORT IN MONROE COUNTY,
5 MISSISSIPPI, AND TO LEASE THE BUILDING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
6 SAFETY, FREE OF CHARGE, FOR UTILIZATION AS A FACILITY FOR ISSUING
7 COMMERCIAL AND REGULAR DRIVERS' LICENSES; AND FOR RELATED
8 PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Board of Supervisors of Monroe County,
11 Mississippi, the governing authorities of the City of Amory and
12 the governing authorities of the City of Aberdeen may construct a
13 building at the Monroe County Airport in Monroe County,
14 Mississippi, for the purpose of leasing the building to the
15 Department of Public Safety, free of charge, for utilization as a
16 facility for issuing commercial and regular drivers' licenses,
17 provided that the Department of Public Safety is authorized by law
18 to enter into such a lease.

19 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Monroe County, Mississippi,
20 the governing authorities of the City of Amory and the governing
21 authorities of the City of Aberdeen shall provide the property for
22 the construction of this facility.

23 (3) The cost of the facility shall not exceed One Hundred
24 Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00). The Board of Supervisors
25 of Monroe County, Mississippi, shall pay, from any funds available
26 to the county, fifty percent (50%) of the cost of the construction
27 of the facility; the governing authorities of the City of Amory
28 shall pay, from any funds available to the city, twenty-five
29 percent (25%) of the cost of the construction of the facility; and
30 the governing authorities of the City of Aberdeen shall pay, from

31 any funds available to the city, twenty-five percent (25%) of the
32 cost of the construction of the facility.

33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
34 and after its passage.
