## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND THE MISSISSIPPI  
2 CONSTITUTION OF 1890 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING THE  
3 RIGHT TO HUNT AND FISH AS A CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT; AND FOR RELATED  
4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF  
6 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi  
7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the  
8 state:

9 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by adding a new  
10 section to read as follows:

11 "Section \_\_. All persons shall have the right to hunt and  
12 fish in this state in accordance with law and regulations.

13 This amendment shall be known as the Sportsperson's Bill of  
14 Rights."

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be  
16 submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on  
17 the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2006, as  
18 provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed  
20 constitutional amendment for the ballot shall read as follows:

21 "This amendment makes hunting and fishing constitutional rights in  
22 Mississippi, subject to applicable laws and regulations."
