HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. ART WAYMIRE FOR HIS
 OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FIELD OF FORESTRY.
 WHEREAS, Mr. Art Waymire of Foxden Plantation is one of the
 best cooperators in Marshall County, whose interests are equally
 divided between soil and water conservation, timber production,
 wildlife and aesthetics; and
 WHEREAS, his commitment to these areas in the last five years

8 has been evidenced by the harvesting of 25 acres of bug-damaged
9 pine saw-timber, reforestation of approximately 569 acres, heavy
10 herbicide site preparation of 569 acres, herbicide release of 460
11 acres and permanent firebreaks of 18 miles; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Waymire has used his expertise in forestry to 12 educate the community by hosting two adult forestry field days for 13 teachers and students of Rust College, five youth groups for tree 14 15 planting and tree identification, Arbor Day Tree Planting projects, Earth Day celebrations, Youth Forestry Field Day-Theme: 16 "Environment," the 2003 Forestry Field Day on the grounds of the 17 Audubon Center and opening his farm to the "Catch-A-Dream" 18 19 program; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Waymire has received numerous awards for his 21 work, such as the 1997 Award for Outstanding Conservation 22 Landowner, the 2002 Northeast District Tree Farmer, the 2002 23 Mississippi Conservationist of the Year and the 2003 Northeast 24 Mississippi Tree Farmer of the Year; and

25 WHEREAS, this great forester has not only received various 26 awards, he has been featured in a number of newspapers around this 27 state, such as the South Reporter, the Sunday Regional Edition of H. C. R. No. 9 *HR07/R177* N1/2 05/HR07/R177 PAGE 1 (GT\HS) 28 the Northeast Mississippi Daily Journal, and the Pigeon Roost
29 News; and

30 WHEREAS, to maintain his level of excellence in the field of 31 forestry, Mr. Waymire belongs to a number of forestry 32 associations, such as the Marshall County Forestry Association, 33 Mississippi Forestry Association, Forest Landowners Association, 34 Mississippi Wildlife Federation and the Marshall County Soil and 35 Water Conservation; and

36 WHEREAS, the best evidence of his skills as a forester exists 37 in Foxden Plantation, a 2,021 acre farm, in which Mr. Waymire has 38 executed every part of his Stewardship Incentive Plan by 39 rehabilitating all of the land, water and wildlife resources that 40 were in disaster; and

41 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature of the State of 42 Mississippi to recognize remarkable foresters who help to 43 revitalize the lands of our great state:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Mr. Art Waymire for his
outstanding contributions to the field of forestry and extend our
heartiest wishes for success in all his future endeavors.
