- 2 DELEGATION OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI PROTECT WORKERS FROM UNION

- 4 WHEREAS, every American has the right to expect a workplace
- 5 free of violence; and
- 6 WHEREAS, some labor unions have resorted to violence,
- 7 bribery, and extortion in their workplace unionization campaigns;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, this violence has not only confined itself to the
- 10 workplace, but has spilled over into other areas of American civic
- 11 life, including political campaigns; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the people have a constitutional right to expect
- 13 their free speech exercises to be respected by their fellow
- 14 citizens and protected by law; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Congress has in the past sought to restrict union
- 16 violence via the Hobbs Act, which was thrown out by judicial
- 17 activism:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 19 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 20 THEREIN, That the Mississippi Legislature requests that the
- 21 Congressmen and Senators from our state vote to reauthorize the
- 22 Hobbs Act to restrict union violence.
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copes of this resolution be
- 24 furnished to Mississippi's Congressional Delegation and to the
- 25 members of the Capitol Press Corps.
