- 2 DELEGATION OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO WORK TO ABOLISH THE
- 3 DEATH TAX PERMANENTLY.
- WHEREAS, under tax relief legislation passed in 2001, the
- 5 death tax was temporarily phased out but not permanently
- 6 eliminated; and
- 7 WHEREAS, farmers and other small business owners will face
- 8 losing their farms and businesses if the federal government
- 9 resumes the heavy taxation of citizens at death; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this is a tax that is particularly damaging to
- 11 families who are working their way up the ladder and trying to
- 12 accumulate wealth for the first time; and
- WHEREAS, employees suffer layoffs when small and medium
- 14 businesses are liquidated to pay death taxes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, if the death tax had been repealed in 1996, the
- 16 United States economy would have realized billions of dollars each
- 17 year in extra output and an average of 145,000 additional new jobs
- 18 would have been created; and
- 19 WHEREAS, having repeatedly passed in the United States House
- 20 of Representatives and Senate, repeal of the death tax holds wide
- 21 bipartisan support:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 23 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 24 THEREIN, That the Mississippi Legislature requests that our
- 25 elected representatives and senators in the United States Congress
- 26 support, work to pass and vote for the immediate and permanent
- 27 repeal of the death tax.
