HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 73 (As Adopted by the House and Senate)

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO 1 ESTABLISH A DOMESTIC ENERGY POLICY TO ENSURE AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY 2 3 AND APPROPRIATE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR NATURAL GAS, PROMOTE GREATER 4 ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND OPEN PROMISING NEW AREAS FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY RESPONSIBLE NATURAL GAS PRODUCTION. 5 б WHEREAS, because of the current state of our nation, we are 7 reminded daily that America is now at the mercy of foreign oil 8 producing nations; and 9 WHEREAS, America's dependence on foreign oil directly threatens our national security and our freedom; and 10 WHEREAS, the development of a domestic energy policy by 11 Congressional legislation enacting a National Energy Security Act 12 would reduce the United States' dependence on foreign countries 13 14 for more than fifty-six percent (56%) of our nation's energy needs; and 15 WHEREAS, we should seek to reduce America's dependency on 16 foreign oil up to fifty percent (50%) by 2010, down from the 17 current fifty-six percent (56%), and much lower than the predicted 18 19 sixty-five percent (65%) dependency expected by 2020; and 20 WHEREAS, in seeking out measures to enhance the usage of 21 renewable energy resources including hydro, nuclear, coal, solar 22 and wind power, Congress should also seek to increase domestic supplies of nonrenewable resources, like oil and natural gas; and 23 24 WHEREAS, without a national energy policy, millions of Americans will continue to endure mandated power outages due to 25 the lack of a power infrastructure or find themselves faced with 26 27 larger power bills due to increased demand and limited production 28 of energy; and
