HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 111
(As Adopted by the House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE 2005 REGULAR SESSION OF
2 THE LEGISLATURE, SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION, FILING AND ADOPTION OF
4 CONFERENCE REPORTS ON APPROPRIATION BILLS, AND FIXING THE DATE OF
5 SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT OF THE 2005 REGULAR SESSION OF THE
6 LEGISLATURE.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
8 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
9 THEREIN, That the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature is
10 extended for a period of thirty (30) days from the final day of
11 the ninety (90) calendar days of the 2005 Regular Session of the
12 Legislature, under the provisions of Section 36, Mississippi
13 Constitution of 1890.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Rules of the House and
15 the Senate, including all the deadlines and other provisions
16 imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for the purpose of
17 permitting the further consideration, filing and adoption of
18 conference reports on appropriation bills after the deadlines for
19 those actions in Joint Rule No. 40.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2005 Regular Session of the
21 Legislature will stand adjourned Sine Die at 12:00 midnight,
22 Tuesday, April 5, 2005.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution supersedes the
24 provisions of House Concurrent Resolution No. 108, 2005 Regular
25 Session.
