A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CONTRIBUTIONS AND SELFLESSNESS OF 1 WORLD WAR II VETERAN HOWARD DUER TO THE HURLEY COMMUNITY. 2 3 WHEREAS, Howard Duer, a resident of Hurley, Mississippi, 4 since 1954, has epitomized the model of citizenry in giving, commitment, zeal for life and community spirit at its best through 5 his unwavering dedication to give back to his community and 6 7 selfless devotion to that very cause; and 8 WHEREAS, born January 23, 1924, in Marquette, Michigan, Mr. 9 Duer moved to Chatom, Alabama, at the age of 13 and began a career with civil service when he was 18, working at Brookley Air Force 10 11 Base in Mobile; and WHEREAS, joining the Air Force after having worked on the 12 base, Mr. Duer served in the Air Force until World War II ended, 13 returning to Brookley until the beginning of the Korean War, when 14 15 he was again deployed; and WHEREAS, upon his second return to Brookley, Mr. Duer met his 16 17 wife, Lavonia, and they were wed on November 27, 1954, moving to Hurley later that year; and 18 WHEREAS, a charter member of the East Central Volunteer Fire 19 20 Department and also the county's ambulance service as a volunteer Emergency Medical Technician, Mr. Duer retired from civil service 21 22 in 1978, at which time he began working as a maintenance man at 23 East Central School; and WHEREAS, Mr. Duer worked diligently at East Central until his 24 25 seventieth birthday, and remains active as a pillar of the community through his work and volunteerism with the Hurley 26 27 Volunteer Fire Department, East Central High School, East Central *HR07/R1067* H.
