1 2 3	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING NORTH PONTOTOC HIGH SCHOOL UPON BEING NAMED A BLUE RIBBON SCHOOL BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.
4	WHEREAS, now in an elite group of slightly more than 250
5	schools nationwide, North Pontotoc High School was named a Blue
6	Ribbon School last September by the United States Department of
7	Education; and
8	WHEREAS, with well over 100,000 public and private schools in
9	the country, fewer than 300 can claim to be Blue Ribbon Schools,
10	representing less than half a percent of the nation's schools
11	receiving this grand honor; and
12	WHEREAS, since 1982, the Department of Education has named
13	Blue Ribbon Schools to recognize excellence, awarding schools Blue
14	Ribbons because they exemplify the great promise of No Child Left
15	Behind; and
16	WHEREAS, the quantitative criteria employed in selecting
17	schools for Blue Ribbon status consist of three elements: schools
18	with a high percentage of disadvantaged students that are making
19	dramatic improvements on state assessments, schools whose students
20	score in the top 10 percent on state tests, and private schools
21	that perform in the top 10 percent of schools nationally; and
22	WHEREAS, because of the commitment and dedication of the
23	administrators and teachers coupled with the drive, ambition and
24	perseverance of the students, North Pontotoc High School has set
25	the benchmark of excellence in education by receiving such a

widely acclaimed honor; and
