## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 60

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE CHARLESTON  
2 HIGH SCHOOL TIGERS FOOTBALL TEAM FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING SEASON OF  
3 PLAY FOR 2004 AND WINNING THE REGION 2-3A CHAMPIONSHIP.
