HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 71

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE RETIRED TEACHERS AND EMPLOYEES OF  
2 THE GREENWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THEIR YEARS OF DEDICATED
