- 18 Judge in the Town of Edwards in January 2001; and

- 20 is a member of the NAACP, Southern Christian Leadership Conference
- 21 (SCLC), charter member of the Jackson Chapter of SCLC and member
- 22 of the Cade Chapel Missionary Baptist Church, where he was a
- 23 Sunday School teacher; and
- 24 WHEREAS, having a deep passion for the plight of the city and
- 25 state's youth, Judge Britton has worked with Walton Elementary
- 26 School under the Adopt-a-School Program, the City of Jackson's
- 27 After-School Program at the Medgar Evers Center in the Virden

- 28 Addition Neighborhood and the City of Jackson Park and Recreation
- 29 Department's Summer Youth Program; and
- 30 WHEREAS, for his distinguished and committed community
- 31 service, Judge Britton has received numerous honors from civic
- 32 groups, various churches and the City of Jackson, including:
