SENATE BILL NO. 2025

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-41-16, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE CRIME OF MALICIOUS OR MISCHIEVOUS INJURY TO CERTAIN PETS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 97-41-16, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:
97-41-16. (1) Any person who shall maliciously, either out

8 of a spirit of revenge or wanton cruelty, or who shall 9 mischievously kill, maim or wound, or injure any dog <u>or cat</u>, or 10 cause any person to do the same, shall be fined not more than One 11 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or be imprisoned not exceeding six 12 (6) months.

13 (2) In addition to such fine or imprisonment which may be 14 imposed, the court shall order that restitution be made to the 15 owner of such dog <u>or cat</u>. The measure for restitution in money 16 shall be the current replacement value of such loss and/or the 17 actual veterinarian fees, special supplies, loss of income and 18 other cost incurred as a result of actions in violation of 19 subsection (1) of this section.

20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 21 and after July 1, 2005.
