SENATE BILL NO. 2076

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF U.S. HIGHWAY 84 IN JONES
2 COUNTY AS "VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN
3 OVERPASS ON INTERSTATE 59 IN PEARL RIVER COUNTY AS "DEPUTY LEN J
4 ROWELL MEMORIAL BRIDGE"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) That segment of U.S. Highway 84 located in
7 Jones County beginning from 16th Avenue within the corporate
8 limits of Laurel and extending westerly to the Jones/Covington
9 county line is designated and shall be known as the "Veterans
10 Memorial Highway."

11 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
12 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
13 of highway described in subsection (1).

14 **SECTION 2.** (1) The overpass located at exit 35 on
15 Interstate 59 in Pearl River County is designated and shall be
16 known as the "Deputy Len J Rowell Memorial Bridge."

17 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
18 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the overpass
19 described in subsection (1).

20 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after July 1, 2005.
