The clerk or his successor in office shall perform all duties set 65 66 forth without additional compensation or fee to wit:

Cost of process shall be borne by the issuing party. Additionally, should the attorney or person filing the pleadings 82 desire the clerk to pay the cost to the sheriff for serving 83 84 process on one person or more, or to pay the cost of publication, the clerk shall demand the actual charges therefor, at the time of 85 86 filing.

87 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 88 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 89 90 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 91 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the

94 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 95 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 96 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, or October 1, 2005, 97 whichever occurs later.
