SENATE BILL NO. 2390

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-61-55, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THAT THE STATE MEDICAL EXAMINER SHALL BE BOARD-CERTIFIED IN FORENSIC PATHOLOGY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 41-61-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:
41-61-55. There is hereby created the position of State

8 Medical Examiner, to be established as herein provided under the
9 appointment by and supervision of the Commissioner of Public
10 Safety.

Each applicant for the position of State Medical Examiner shall, as a minimum, be a physician who is eligible for a license to practice medicine in Mississippi and be <u>board-certified</u> in forensic pathology *** * ***.

The State Medical Examiner may be removed by the commissioner only for inefficiency or other good cause, after written notice and a hearing complying with due process of law.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19 and after July 1, 2005.
