- 11 Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be
- 12 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not
- more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
- 14 (2) No county, municipality or other political subdivision
- 15 shall enact any ordinance restricting the use of cellular phones
- 16 in any motor vehicle until such time as the state may authorize a
