## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2449

1	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN POLLUTION CONTROL EQUIPMENT

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) Pollution control equipment purchased after
- 8 July 1, 2005, by manufacturers or custom processors for industrial
- 9 use shall be exempt from ad valorem taxation, except ad valorem
- 10 taxes for school district purposes, for a period of ten (10) years
- 11 from the date of acquisition of the equipment.
- 12 (2) As used in this section, "pollution control equipment"
- 13 means equipment, devices, machinery or systems that are used
- 14 exclusively and directly to prevent, control, monitor or reduce
- 15 air, water or groundwater pollution, or solid or hazardous waste
- 16 as required by federal or state law or regulation.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
