- SECTION 1. Section 23-15-217, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8

- the office of commissioner of election or with reference to which 13
- he has acted as such; provided that he has resigned from the 14
- office of election commissioner before he qualifies for the office 15
- which he desires to seek. * * * 16
- (2) In any case involving the election of a county election 17
- commissioner wherein there is a contest of any nature, including, 18
- but not limited to, the right of any person to vote or the 19
