## SENATE BILL NO. 2590

 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-15-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO JOINTLY DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN AN ADOPTION RESOURCE EXCHANGE REGISTRY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 43-15-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

43-15-19. (1) The State Department of Human Services and 8 9 the Mississippi State Department of Health shall jointly maintain 10 a Mississippi Adoption Resource Exchange registry, which shall contain (a) a total listing of all children freed for adoption, 11 (b) a listing of all persons who wish to adopt children and who 12 are approved by a licensed adoption agency in the state of 13 Mississippi, and (c) statistical information on the number of 14 adoption petitions filed and approved in each chancery court 15 16 district in the state, to be made available to the department by the senior chancellor of each chancery court district. Said 17 registry shall be distributed to all county welfare directors and 18 19 licensed adoption agencies within the state and shall be updated at least quarterly. The State Department of Human Services and 20 21 the State Department of Health shall establish regulations for listing descriptive characteristics while protecting the privacy 22 23 of the children's names. Listed names shall be removed when adoption placement plans are made for a child or when a person 24 withdraws an application for adoption. 25

26 (2) Adoptive parents shall be given the option of having 27 their names placed in the registry. They shall be required to 28 give written authority to the county <u>human services</u> department to S. B. No. 2590 \*SS02/R1211\* G1/2 05/SS02/R1211 PAGE 1 29 place their names in the registry and said authorization shall be 30 forwarded to the <u>Department of Human Services</u>, Office of Children 31 <u>and Youth</u>, for approval.

## 32 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 33 and after July 1, 2005.
