BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 31 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 32 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 33 34 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 35 36 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 37 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 38 39 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a supporter of the Mississippi Poultry Association, Inc. The application and the 48 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 49 50 Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 51 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 52 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county 53 54 general fund.

The additional fee paid shall be for a 60 61 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 62 63 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 64 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 65 66 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 67 68 collector.

69 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 70 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, 71 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected 72 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute 73 such collections as follows:
