- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild 49-7-33.
- 8 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of 9
- calls of any kind, except a person may use electrically amplified 10
- sound devices for hunting coyote and crow. The commission, in its 11
- 12 discretion, may relax the restrictions regarding the use of lures
- 13 or sound devices if a condition arises or exists, as decided by
- the State Board of Health or county board of health, that may 14
- 15 endanger persons or livestock in a certain community, county or
- 16 area.
- (2) A person may use liquid scents for any animal or bird. 17
- 18 (3) A person may use bait to trap wild hogs as defined in
- Section 49-7-140 during the period between the end of Spring 19
- turkey season and the beginning of deer season with bow and arrow. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after its passage. 22
