SENATE BILL NO. 2747

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-1-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROHIBIT THE WORKING OF STATE INMATES BY INDIVIDUALS FOR PRIVATE 3 PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 47-1-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 47-1-19. (1) It <u>is</u> unlawful for any <u>state or</u> county 8 prisoner or prisoners to be leased or hired to any individual or 9 corporation for any purpose whatsoever. Nor shall they be worked 10 under any contractor; but in working them on county farms, or on 11 the public roads or on any other work, which work must be of an 12 exclusively public character, they shall be under exclusive 13 official control and management.

14 (2) (a) It is lawful for a county or municipality to 15 provide prisoners for public service work for nonprofit charitable 16 organizations as defined under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal 17 Revenue Code if that nonprofit charitable organization provides 18 food to charities.

(b) The prisoners participating in the public service
work under paragraph (a) shall remain under the exclusive control
and management of the county or municipality.

(c) A prisoner performing public service work under
this subsection shall be entitled to earned credits as provided
under this chapter.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after its passage.
