SENATE BILL NO. 2819

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-1-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 TRANSFER THE LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNCTIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR 3 CARRIER REGULATORY LAW OF 1938 FROM THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF 4 TRANSPORTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 77-1-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

77-1-21. (1) For the purpose of enforcing the provisions of 9 the Mississippi Motor Carrier Regulatory Law of 1938, the * * * 10 Department of Public Safety is authorized to employ, in addition 11 to personnel already employed by the department, law enforcement 12 13 officers, who shall be under the management of the department. 14 Such officers shall devote their full time to the performance of their duties and shall take an oath faithfully to perform the 15 16 duties of their position. The department shall require bonds to 17 be carried on such employees as the department may deem necessary, the cost thereof to be paid by the department. Such law 18 19 enforcement officers shall be qualified by experience and training in law enforcement or investigative work, and shall attend and 20 21 satisfactorily complete an appropriate course of instruction 22 established by the Commissioner of Public Safety at the Law 23 Enforcement Officers Training Academy. The law enforcement 24 officers referred to in this section shall be selected after an examination as to physical and mental fitness. Such employees 25 shall be citizens of the United States and the State of 26 27 Mississippi, and of good moral character. All such members of

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staff shall be appointed by the * * * Department of Public Safety 28 29 and shall be subject to removal at any time by the department. The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall 30 (2) transfer all law enforcement officers, equipment, inventory and 31 32 resources of the department employed and used to enforce the Motor Carrier Regulatory Law of 1938 to the * * * Department of Public 33 Safety on July 1, 2005. The transfer of personnel shall be 34 commensurate with the number and classification of positions 35 allocated to that law enforcement. The transfer also shall 36 include direct support, clerical, data processing and 37 38 communications positions allocated to that law enforcement. (3) The Public Service Commission shall transfer to 39 40 the * * * Department of Public Safety each year the amount of funds necessary to support the law enforcement functions being 41 performed for the commission by the department, as specified in 42 the appropriation bill for the Public Service Commission. 43 Any reference in any statute, rule or regulation to law 44 (4) 45 enforcement duties being performed by the Public Service Commission shall be construed to mean law enforcement duties being 46 47 performed for the commission by the * * * Department of Public 48 Safety.

49 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 50 and after its passage.
