SENATE BILL NO. 2832

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-3-123, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO REVISE ENROLLMENT FEES FOR THE MISSISSIPPI BAR; AND FOR RELATED
3 PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-3-123, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 73-3-123. Each member of the bar shall, unless exempt by
8 virtue of Section 73-3-125, pay enrollment fees each year in an
9 amount as established by the Board of Commissioners, but not to
10 exceed the sum of Two Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$270.00) for those
11 members admitted to practice law for three (3) years or more; and
12 One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$130.00) for those members admitted to
13 practice law for one (1) year, but less than three (3) years; and
14 Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) for those members admitted to practice
15 law less than one (1) year; and Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for those
16 members on inactive status. All enrollment fees shall be paid for
17 the same period, that is, for the period of one (1) year beginning
18 on the day and month to be determined as provided in Section
19 73-3-127. The enrollment fees shall be paid to the secretary of
20 the bar.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after July 1, 2005.
