SENATE BILL NO. 2836

1 AN ACT TO DELETE A CERTAIN SECTION OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 844  
2 IN COPIAH COUNTY FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM; TO REMOVE IT FROM  
3 THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; AND  
4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The following highway is deleted from the state  
7 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi  
8 Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the  
9 Board of Supervisors of Copiah County:

10 **Central District - Copiah County:**

11 Mississippi Highway 844 beginning on U.S. Highway 51 and  
12 proceeding easterly on South Pat Harrison Drive, thence  
13 northerly on South Jackson Street, West Georgetown  
14 Street and North Jackson Street, thence westerly on  
15 North Pat Harrison Drive to U.S. Highway 51, for a total  
16 approximate length of 3.57 miles, all within Crystal  
17 Springs, Copiah County.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
19 and after its passage.
