## SENATE BILL NO. 2861

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW TRAPPERS TO SELL SKINS AND MEAT AFTER THE CLOSE OF TRAPPING 1 2 SEASON; TO AMEND 49-7-65, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM; 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 49-7-13. (1) Any resident of the state sixteen (16) years 8 9 of age or older, upon application, is entitled to receive a state 10 trapper's license with tag for the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), plus the fee provided in Section 49-7-17 \* \* \*. This 11 license shall be required of each helper or assistant sixteen (16) 12 years of age or older employed or used by a trapper. 13

14 (2) No person shall trap \* \* \* on <u>the</u> lands \* \* \* <u>of</u> another 15 \* \* \* unless he has <u>the permission of</u> the landowner \* \* \*.

16 (3) <u>Each</u> trap shall have an identification number \* \* \*
17 permanently inscribed \* \* \* on <u>the trap or attached to the trap by</u>
18 <u>a metal tag.</u> \* \* \* Every trapper shall \* \* \* visit his traps at
19 least every thirty-six (36) hours. The conservation officer <u>may</u>
20 take up any traps not properly marked.

(4) No person shall place or set a trap on or within one
hundred (100) feet of any street or public road. Public roads
shall not be construed to mean public waterways.

(5) This section shall not apply to a landowner trapping onhis own lands except subsection (4).

26 (6) A <u>trapper</u> shall be allowed to <u>trap</u> \* \* \* fur-bearing and
27 predatory animals during trapping season, and sell the pelts

The meat of legally acquired raccoons, opossums and 30 muskrats may also be bought and sold during trapping season, and 31 for ten (10) days after the close of the season.

32 SECTION 2. Section 49-7-65, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 33 amended as follows:

34 49-7-65. Except as provided in this chapter, it is unlawful for any person to hunt, trap, take, kill, wound or capture, or 35 attempt to hunt, trap, take, kill, wound or capture any 36 fur-bearing animals \* \* \* except during the open season prescribed 37 by law or regulation, or to have in his possession the green pelt 38 39 of any such animal except during the open season and ten (10) days after the close of the open season. However, mink may be hunted 40 41 with dogs during the season for taking of fur-bearing animals on payment of trapper's license fee by person so hunting mink with 42 dogs. 43

44 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 45 and after July 1, 2005.
