SENATE BILL NO. 2878

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO ALLOW CHILDREN OF MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO COMPLETE THEIR SENIOR
3	YEAR IN A MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL TO RETAIN RESIDENCY STATUS AS
4	LONG AS THEY ATTEND A MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY; AND FOR
5	RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-103-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-103-19. Resident status of children of members of the
- 10 armed forces on extended active duty shall be that of the military
- 11 parent for the purpose of attending state-supported institutions
- 12 of higher learning and junior colleges of the State of Mississippi
- 13 during the time that their military parents are stationed within
- 14 the State of Mississippi and shall be continued through the time
- 15 that military parents are stationed in an overseas area with last
- 16 duty assignment within the State of Mississippi, excepting
- 17 temporary training assignments en route from Mississippi.
- 18 Resident status of minor children shall terminate upon
- 19 reassignment under Permanent Change of Station Orders of their
- 20 military parents for duty in the continental United States outside
- 21 the State of Mississippi, excepting temporary training assignments
- 22 en route from Mississippi. Children of members of the armed
- 23 forces who attain Mississippi residency in accordance with the
- 24 above provisions, who begin and complete their senior year of high
- 25 school in Mississippi, and who enroll full-time in a Mississippi
- 26 institution of higher learning or junior college to begin studies
- 27 in the fall after their graduation from high school, shall

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28 maintain their residency status so long as they remain enrolled

- 29 and a student in good standing at a Mississippi institution of
- 30 higher learning or junior college, provided that enrollment during
- 31 summer school shall not be required hereunder.
- 32 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 33 and after July 1, 2005.
