13	calls of any kind, except a person:

16	(b) May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and
17	(c) May hunt deer with the aid of bait on privately
18	owned or leased lands if the commission allows the use of bait as

20	(2) The commission, in its discretion, may relax the
21	restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a
22	condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of

(3) The commission may allow the hunting of deer with the

aid of bait on privately owned or leased lands. If the commission

allows the use of bait, the commission shall issue regulations to

implement a baiting program, to control disease and to insure the
