SENATE BILL NO. 2957

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT THE DRIVER'S LICENSE APPLICATION SHALL CLEARLY LIST 3 ALL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED ON THE FACE THEREOF; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 63-1-19. (1) (a) Every applicant for a license or permit 9 issued pursuant to this article, or for renewal of such license or 10 permit, shall file an application for such license, permit or renewal, on a form provided by the Department of Public Safety, 11 with the commissioner or an official license examiner of the 12 department. All persons not holding valid, unexpired licenses 13 issued in this state shall be required to secure an original 14 license, except those specifically exempted from licensing under 15 16 Section 63-1-7. The application shall state the name, date of 17 birth, the social security number of the applicant unless the applicant is not a United States citizen and does not possess a 18 19 social security number issued by the United States government, sex, race, color of eyes, color of hair, weight, height and 20 21 residence address, and whether or not the applicant's privilege to drive has been suspended or revoked at any time, and, if so, when, 22 23 by whom, and for what cause, and whether any previous application by him has been denied, and whether he has any physical defects 24 which would interfere with his operating a motor vehicle safely 25 26 upon the highways.

27 (b) Every applicant for an original license shall show
28 proof of domicile in this state. The commissioner shall

29 promulgate any rules and regulations necessary to enforce this 30 requirement and shall prescribe the means by which an applicant 31 for an original license may show domicile in this state. Proof of 32 domicile shall not be required of applicants under eighteen (18) 33 years of age.

34 (c) Unless the applicant is not a United States citizen
35 and does not possess a social security number issued by the United
36 States government, each application or filing made under this
37 section shall include the social security number(s) of the
38 applicant in accordance with Section 93-11-64, Mississippi Code of
39 1972.

40 (d) Every legal requirement and all documentation
41 necessary for obtaining a license shall be clearly listed on the
42 face of the application form.

43 (2) No person who is illegally in the United States or Mississippi shall be issued a license. The application of a 44 45 person who is not a United States citizen and who does not possess 46 a social security number issued by the United States government shall state the name, date of birth, sex, race, color of eyes, 47 48 color of hair, weight, height and residence address, and whether 49 or not the applicant's privilege to drive has been suspended or 50 revoked at any time, and, if so, when, by whom, and for what cause, and whether any previous application by him has been 51 52 denied, and whether he has any physical defects which would 53 interfere with his operating a motor vehicle safely upon the highways. The commissioner shall adopt and promulgate such rules 54 55 and regulations as he deems appropriate requiring additional 56 documents, materials, information or physical evidence to be 57 provided by the applicant as may be necessary to establish the identity of the applicant and that the applicant is not present in 58 59 the United States or the State of Mississippi illegally. 60 (3) (a) Any male who is at least eighteen (18) years of age 61 but less than twenty-six (26) years of age and who applies for a *SS01/R1228* S. 62 permit or license or a renewal of a permit or license under this 63 chapter shall be registered in compliance with the requirements of 64 Section 3 of the Military Selective Service Act, 50 USCS Appx 451 65 et seq., as amended.

66 (b) The department shall forward in an electronic 67 format the necessary personal information of the applicant to the 68 Selective Service System. The applicant's submission of the application shall serve as an indication that the applicant either 69 has already registered with the Selective Service System or that 70 71 he is authorizing the department to forward to the Selective 72 Service System the necessary information for registration. The commissioner shall notify the applicant on, or as a part of, the 73 74 application that his submission of the application will serve as his consent to registration with the Selective Service System, if 75 so required. The commissioner also shall notify any male 76 applicant under the age of eighteen (18) that he will be 77 78 registered upon turning age eighteen (18) as required by federal 79 law.

80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after January 1, 2006.
