- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 10 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 11 minimum:
- 12 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 13 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 14 Education.
- 15 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 16 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 17 school board.
- 18 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 19 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 20 in a form prescribed by the state board.
- 21 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 22 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 23 graduation.
- 24 (4) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 25 testing proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels for
- 26 students in home instruction programs which are equivalent to
- 27 requirements applicable to public school students.
