With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 42 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 46 47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 99 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 100 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable 101 College Tuition Trust Fund for the purpose of paying all amounts 102 due for prepaid tuition contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid 103 Affordable College Tuition Program, for the fiscal year beginning 104 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006...... \$ 15,500,000.00.

SECTION 12. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall 168 be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said 169 170 funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person 171 172 who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree, computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing 173 174 or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the event of any such payment, then the official or person approving 175 176 and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and 177 severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or 178 179 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General; provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person 180 181 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this provision shall not apply. 182

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 183 SECTION 13. 184 Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 185 186 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such 187 records shall be in the same format and level of details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 188 189 the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall 190 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 191 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 192 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 194 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 195 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 196 197 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 198 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 199 200 and after July 1, 2005.
