## SENATE BILL NO. 3061

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the administrative expenses of the State Board for
9	Community and Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 5,303,572.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13	Treasury to the credit of the State Board for Community and Junior
14	Colleges, for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses
15	of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the
16	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
17	\$ 45,177,905.00.
18	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
19	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
20	Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School and
21	College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the expenses
22	incurred in the regulation and administration of the Mississippi
23	Proprietary School and College Registration Law and the associated
24	expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for
25	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
26	\$ 60,000.00.

27	SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
28	Sections 1, 2, and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below
29	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
30	expenditure:

51	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
52	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
53	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
54	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
55	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
56	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
57	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
58	budget requests of the administrative expenses of the State Board
59	for Community and Junior Colleges for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
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60 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
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- 61 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 62 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
- 63 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated herein, One Million
- 04 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended from the Work Force
- 65 Carryover Fund as created by House Bill No. 1271, 1995 Regular
- 66 Session.
- 67 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 68 funds in the amount of Eighteen Million Twenty-two Thousand
- 69 Seventy-three Dollars (\$18,022,073.00) are appropriated for the
- 70 Workforce Education Program and Industrial Training. No funding
- 71 obligation or commitment shall be made on behalf of the state for
- 72 industrial training beyond the level of funding made available in
- 73 this section. All industrial training program commitments made in
- 74 Fiscal Year 2006 and future fiscal years shall be based only upon
- 75 funds available in this section and any proposed commitments shall
- 76 be approved by the Executive Director of the State Board for
- 77 Community and Junior Colleges, or the Executive Director's
- 78 designee prior to such commitment being finalized. Industrial
- 79 training program commitments shall be made and based only upon
- 80 training services provided and not for a specific funding amount.
- 81 Any expenditures of funds authorized in this section are limited
- 82 to obligations made July 1, 2005, or after, and shall not be
- 83 expended for obligations made prior to this date.
- 84 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in
- 85 the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall
- 86 be derived from Community College Network fees and Mississippi
- 87 Virtual Community College fees for the purpose of defraying the
- 88 costs of the Community College Network and the administrative
- 89 expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.
- 90 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 91 Section 2, funds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 92 (\$100,000.00) shall be derived from fees charged for issuing

- 93 duplicate transcripts and duplicate diplomas for the General
- 94 Education Development (GED) Testing Program for the purpose of
- 95 defraying the costs of administering the GED Testing Program of
- 96 the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, in accordance
- 97 with Senate Bill No. 2626, 2002 Regular Session.
- 98 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 99 of Section 2, funds in the amount of Three Hundred Thousand
- 100 Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall be derived from fees charged for the
- 101 Workforce On-Line Training Program for the purpose of defraying
- 102 the costs of administering a Workforce On-Line Training Program
- 103 available to individual citizens and employers of the State of
- 104 Mississippi and for the administrative expenses of the State Board
- 105 for Community and Junior Colleges.
- 106 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 107 State Board of Community and Junior Colleges is hereby authorized
- 108 to accept, budget and expend funds from any source in an amount
- 109 not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in accordance
- 110 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 111 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 112 federal funds.
- 113 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in
- 114 the amount of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) shall be
- 115 derived from the transfer of post-secondary vocational and
- 116 technical funds from the Mississippi Department of Education to
- 117 the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose
- 118 of managing the day-to-day operations of post-secondary vocational
- 119 and technical education.
- 120 **SECTION 13.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 121 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 122 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 123 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 124 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 125 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

126 **SECTION 14.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 127 and after July 1, 2005.
