SENATE BILL NO. 3069 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, 2 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the State Department of Agriculture and Commerce, including the Divisions of Support, Plant Industry and 9 Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 7,221,411.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special source funds, which are collected by or otherwise become available 14 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Department of Agriculture and Commerce, including the Divisions of Support 16 and Plant Industry and Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year 17 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 18\$ 19 4,988,874.00. 20 The funds authorized for expenditure under the provisions of 21 this section include subscription fees produced from the Market 22 Bulletin and admission fees produced from the Mississippi 23 Agriculture and Forestry Museum. SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 24 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 25 26 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 27 expenditure:

Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 55 56 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 57 58 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 59 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 60 *SS26/A401PS* S. 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Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 61 62 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 63 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 64 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 65 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 66 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 67 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 68 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 69

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 72 73 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 74 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 75 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 76 77 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 78 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. The funds appropriated and authorized to be 83 expended under the provisions of this act shall be expended for 84 85 the purpose of defraying all expenses incurred by the State Department of Agriculture and Commerce in the operation of all 86 87 programs and activities (except operation of the State Lime 88 Plants, Veterinary Laboratory, Pink Bollworm-Plant Quarantine Inspection Stations and Fire Ant Program) authorized to be 89 conducted and carried on by said department; including, but not 90 91 limited to: the administration of the Feed, Fertilizer and Dairy 92 Act; the Weights and Measure Act; the Meat Inspection Act of 1968; 93 the Mississippi Pure Seed Law; and the following additional *SS26/A401PS* S. B. No. 3069 05/SS26/A401PS

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94 programs and activities: enforcement of the egg law; publication 95 and distribution of the Mississippi Market Bulletin, agricultural 96 statistics, market news service at Stoneville, Mississippi; and 97 inspection, grading and certifying of fruits, vegetables, hay, 98 grain, meat and meat products, milk and dairy products, pecans, 99 seed and syrup.

100 The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and SECTION 5. Commerce, with the assistance of the State Department of Audit and 101 102 the Department of Finance and Administration, shall establish nonbudgeted enterprise funds for all "for profit" activities 103 104 related to the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum. The funds shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted 105 106 accounting principles and regulations prescribed by the Department 107 of Finance and Administration.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Department of Agriculture and Commerce is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds from any source in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

114 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 115 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Beaver Control Program or from any 116 other special source funds made available to the Beaver Control 117 118 Program, to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the support of the Beaver Control Program for the fiscal year 119 120 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 121\$ 500,000.00.

Of the special funds authorized in this section, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be derived from funds received from the Mississippi Department of Transportation and Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be derived from counties and from fees charged private persons/organizations.

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SECTION 8. Of the funds provided by the provisions of this 127 128 act, it is the intent of the Legislature that not more than Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) shall be expended for the 129 130 Mississippi Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Pilot Program, which 131 shall be established by the State Department of Agriculture and 132 Commerce to serve senior citizens above sixty (60) years of age who fall within one hundred thirty percent (130%) of the poverty 133 level. The Commissioner of Agriculture may promulgate rules and 134 135 regulations necessary to implement the Mississippi Senior Farmers' 136 Market Nutrition Pilot Program.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 143 144 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department 145 146 of Agriculture and Commerce, for the purpose of making incentive payments to producers of ethanol utilizing Mississippi-produced 147 148 agriculture commodities under the provisions of Section 69-51-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 149 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 150 500,000.00. 151 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 152
