The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Institute for Forest 8 Inventory which is comprised of special source funds and donations 9 collected by or otherwise available to the Institute for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Institute for the period 10 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 11 \$ 12 220,103.00. 13 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 14 15 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 16 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 17 18 Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 19 202,537.00 20 Travel and Subsistence..... 5,000.00 Contractual Services..... 21 7,366.00 Commodities..... 22 5,200.00 23 Capital Outlay: 0.00 24 Other Than Equipment..... 0.00 25 Equipment..... 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 45 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 46 47 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 48 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 56 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. This appropriation is made for the purpose of 68 providing funds to defray the expenses of the Mississippi 69 Institute for Forest Inventory as established in Section 70 49-19-403, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

77 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds 79 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal 80 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 81 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers 82 in the manner provided by law.

83 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after July 1, 2005.
