AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF 2 3 ESTABLISHING A DISASTER RELIEF RESERVE FUND AND DEFRAYING THE 4 COSTS RELATED TO CERTAIN DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS, FOR FISCAL 5 YEAR 2006. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 10 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et 11 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 12 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 13 767,690.00. 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 16 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source 17 funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the 18 19 support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 20 21\$ 3,429,536.00. 22 SECTION 3. 47	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
48	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
49	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
50	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
51	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
52	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
53	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
54	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 69 70 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 71 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 72 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 73 74 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 75 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 76 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 82 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon 83 the request of a local public emergency management organization in an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to 84 85 rural water associations to enable their continued operation when the local emergency management organization determines that such 86 87 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the 88 community.

89 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 90 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall 91 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors, 92 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in 93 disaster management.

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SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 94 95 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 96 97 Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 98 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of 99 disaster assistance programs, including, but not being limited to, public assistance programs, individual and family grant programs, 100 and mitigation programs, for the fiscal year beginning 101 102 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 1,604,720.00. SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 103 104 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management 105 106 Agency Fund Nos. 3724, 3725, 3728, 372U and 372C for the 107 purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the state 108 and federal share of the cost of disaster assistance programs, 109 including, but not being limited to, public assistance programs, individual and family grant programs, and mitigation programs, for 110 111 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 86,439,289.00. 112 113 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 155 156 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 157 158 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

The expenditure of the funds appropriated by this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
