The 391 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 392 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 393 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 394 appropriated level.

395 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 396 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 397 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 398 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

399 SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 400 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 401 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 402 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 403 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 404 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 405 performance measures provided below:

457 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 458 Section 1, authorized for expenditure in Sections 2 and 3, and 459 allocated in Section 4 to the "Central Office," funds are included 460 for an Alzheimer's education and training program.

461 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, authorized for expenditure under the provisions of 462 463 Sections 2 and 3, and allocated under the provisions of Section 4, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) 464 465 may be expended for the support of a pilot project to provide authority for East Mississippi State Hospital and Mississippi 466 467 State Hospital to contract with local hospitals located in counties with a population of less than fifty thousand (50,000) to 468 469 provide emergency inpatient care to individuals committed by the 470 Chancery Court to East Mississippi State Hospital or Mississippi 471 State Hospital for treatment of mental illness if, at the time 472 that such commitment is made, a bed is not available for admission to East Mississippi State Hospital or Mississippi State Hospital. 473 474 East Mississippi State Hospital and Mississippi State Hospital 475 shall have the authority to contract with local hospitals located 476 in counties with a population of less than fifty thousand (50,000) 477 for inpatient emergency care for a period not to exceed seven (7) 478 days at a rate not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty Dollars 479 (\$150.00) per day with East Mississippi State Hospital or Mississippi State Hospital providing One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) 480 481 and the local government providing Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day 482 for such care. Payment for such physician fees shall be made at 483 the Medicaid rate of reimbursement and paid by East Mississippi 484 State Hospital or Mississippi State Hospital. Funds provided for 485 the initiation of this pilot project shall not be expended for 486 inpatient hospital care unless there is participation in the

487 reimbursement for such care by the local government as required by 488 the provisions of this section.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 489 490 Executive Director of the Department of Mental Health shall have 491 authority to transfer cash from one special fund treasury fund to 492 another special fund treasury fund under the control of the 493 Department of Mental Health. The purpose of this authority is to 494 more efficiently use available cash reserves. It is further the 495 intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Mental Health shall submit written justification for 496 497 the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department 498 of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth (15th) of 499 the month prior to the effective date of the transfer.

500 SECTION 9. The Executive Director of the Department of 501 Mental Health and the directors of each separate facility operated 502 by the Department of Mental Health are hereby authorized to 503 transfer spending authority from any major objects to any other 504 major objects in any amounts deemed necessary for the efficient 505 management and operation of their budgets, provided that the total 506 spending authority remains unchanged after such transfers and the total of such transfers into any major object do not exceed 507 508 twenty-five percent (25%) of the original appropriated amount for 509 that major object plus any escalations of spending authority that 510 have occurred during any given fiscal year.

511 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Mental Health shall have the authority to receive, 512 513 budget, and expend funds from any source, including beginning cash in excess of beginning cash when spending authority was initially 514 appropriated, that may become available to the department in 515 accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of 516 517 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the 518 escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 11. The Department of Mental Health and its 519 520 facilities shall have the authority, within funding and spending 521 authority appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, 522 authorized for expenditure in Sections 2 and 3, and allocated 523 under the provisions of Section 4 of this act, to transfer funds 524 to the Division of Medicaid in payment of Medicaid match and designate that the funds thus transferred shall be applied to 525 526 Medicaid match obligations arising in the subsequent fiscal year.

527 SECTION 12. Any person within the Department of Mental 528 Health who must work on a statutory holiday or any holiday 529 proclaimed by the Governor, may at the discretion of the Director 530 of the Institution and the Executive Director of the Department of 531 Mental Health and within available personnel funds, be paid "call 532 back pay" in lieu of "compensatory time credit."

533 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated to the "Service 534 Budget" in the category "Subsidies, Loans and Grants," funds are 535 included for the support of community mental health services for 536 Fiscal Year 2006.

Provided, however, that none of the funds appropriated for 537 538 the support of community mental health services shall be made available to any Regional Mental Health/Retardation Center which 539 540 does not receive from each of its participating counties a dollar 541 amount equivalent to what the proceeds of a three-fourths (3/4)542 mill tax on all taxable property in the county in Fiscal Year 1982 543 would have been or the amount of funds contributed to the center by the county in Fiscal Year 1984, whichever shall be greater. By 544 545 means of performance contracts, the Department of Mental Health 546 shall disburse the funds appropriated in this section for services 547 for the mentally ill, mentally retarded and alcohol/drug abusers. 548 The State Board of Mental Health and the Department of Mental 549 Health shall be responsible for selecting the types of services 550 which shall be provided with the funds appropriated in this

551 section, for developing and monitoring performance contracts and 552 for holding contractors accountable for utilization of funds.

553 SECTION 14. Funds presently included or any funds received 554 in the future for timber funds at Ellisville State School and East 555 Mississippi State Hospital are hereby authorized for transfer to 556 the regular operating budgets of the respective facilities. Each facility shall receive such funds as "Special" funds, and such 557 funds shall be available for use in payment of any and all 558 559 expenses of each facility, paid by the State Treasurer upon 560 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 561 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 562

563 SECTION 15. The Department of Mental Health and its 564 facilities shall have the express legal authority, within funding and spending authority appropriated under the provisions of 565 566 Section 1, authorized for expenditure under the provisions of 567 Sections 2 and 3, and allocated under the provisions of Section 4 568 of this act, to purchase land for use by residential facilities operated by the Department, either directly or by means of 569 570 transferring funds to the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management, and to transfer such funds to Bureau of 571 572 Building, Grounds, and Real Property Management for the purposes of constructing and equipping group homes for persons with mental 573 illness, mental retardation, and/or substance abuse; constructing 574 575 and equipping such other buildings as may be required for treatment of persons with mental illness, mental retardation, 576 577 and/or substance abuse; repair and renovate existing buildings; 578 and to construct, repair and/or renovate employee housing. Any 579 intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICF/MR) 580 constructed with funds authorized in this section shall be 581 authorized to participate in Medicaid funding available for such 582 services.

583 SECTION 16. Of the General Funds appropriated to the "Service Budget" in the category of "Subsidies, Loans and Grants," 584 585 the sum required may be expended to fund the Home and Community 586 Based Waiver Option for community mental retardation services as 587 authorized under Section 43-13-117(29) of the Mississippi Code of 588 1972 (Annotated).

589 SECTION 17. With the funds herein appropriated, the 590 Department of Mental Health is authorized to provide home and 591 community based treatment and institutional treatment to not more 592 than ten (10) persons at any given time who, on or after reaching 593 their twenty-first birthday (age 21), suffered a severe brain injury and whose condition as a result of that brain injury would 594 595 have resulted in their classification as developmentally disabled 596 if such injury had occurred prior to their twenty-first birthday.

597 SECTION 18. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 598 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the 599 special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department 600 of Mental Health Funds 3372, 3373, 3374, 3375, 3376, 3377, 3382, 3384, 3385, 3386, 3387, 3388 and 3391 for the fiscal year 601 602 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....

603\$ 10,000,000.00 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

605 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2005, or change the 606 607 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

608 SECTION 19. None of the funds appropriated herein may be 609 used to pay for alternative residential placement or hospitalization for mental health, mental retardation, or 610 substance treatment of a person committed to the Department of 611 612 Mental Health under Sections 41-21-61 et seq., 41-21-107, 41-31-1 et seq., 43-21-315 and 43-21-611, Mississippi Code of 1972. 613 614 SECTION 20. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 615 of Section 1, authorized for expenditure in Sections 2 and 3, and *SS05/A370* S. B. No. 3080

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616 allocated in Section 4 to Mississippi State Hospital, funds not to 617 exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) may be 618 expended for preplanning costs associated with a project or 619 projects to renovate buildings on the campus of Mississippi State 620 Hospital to meet standards of the Joint Commission on 621 Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

622 SECTION 21. None of the funds appropriated for the support of community mental health, mental retardation, or substance abuse 623 624 services shall be made available to any service provider which, upon determination of the Executive Director of the Department of 625 626 Mental Health, has an outstanding monetary obligation owed to the Department of Mental Health or to the Division of Medicaid, 627 628 pursuant to an audit or programmatic review performed by the 629 Department of Mental Health, that has not been resolved, including 630 those audits or programmatic reviews that occurred prior to July 1, 2005. 631

632 SECTION 22. From the funds provided herein, the Department 633 shall have the authority to adjust salaries of academic teachers 634 and speech pathologists to be commensurate to the teacher's salary 635 scale as provided in the Mississippi Teacher Opportunity Program 636 for the 2005-2006 school year, as outlined in Section 37-19-7, 637 Mississippi Code of 1972, effective July 1, 2004.

SECTION 23. No program or entity certified by the Department 638 639 of Mental Health which also receives state source, federal source, 640 or Medicaid funding directly from the Department of Mental Health 641 or by virtue of state source funds appropriated to the Department 642 of Mental Health for Medicaid match for provision of mental 643 health, mental retardation, or substance abuse services shall pay 644 to any person employed by that program or entity a salary or 645 compensation, directly or indirectly, in excess of the salary 646 provided for a similar position under the classification system of 647 the State Personnel Board for a person with similar credentials, 648 educational level, and directly related years of experience in the *SS05/A370* S. 649 position. Any person whose current salary already exceeds the 650 allowable amount as determined under this section shall be allowed to retain his or her current salary, but no increases shall be 651 652 granted until such time as the allowable maximum salary under the 653 classification system of the State Personnel Board exceeds the 654 current salary paid to that person. Those programs and entities 655 may adopt a system of compensation that includes additional compensation for Educational Benchmarks as allowed under the State 656 657 Personnel Board system. Further, the Department of Mental Health and the State Personnel Board shall collaborate in determining 658 659 similarity of positions in those programs or entities affected by 660 this section to positions within the classification system of the 661 State Personnel Board in any manner they deem appropriate to efficiently implement the provisions of this section. 662 Staff of the State Personnel Board and the Department of Mental Health 663 664 shall be the final authority in the determination of corresponding 665 job titles and pay grades. Failure to comply with the provisions 666 of this section shall be cause to reduce or terminate funding 667 received from the Department of Mental Health.

668 SECTION 24. Special funds appropriated in the Service Budget of the Department of Mental Health shall include an allocation of 669 670 Three Million Five Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Three Hundred 671 Sixty-seven Dollars (\$3,599,367.00) from Title XX Social Services Block Grant funding received by the State of Mississippi, unless 672 673 the total Title XX Social Services Block Grant award received by 674 the State of Mississippi is reduced or increased by the federal 675 government from what was received in federal fiscal year ending September 30, 2005. In cases where the total grant received by 676 677 the State of Mississippi is reduced or increased, the percentage 678 of the grant allocated to the Department of Mental Health shall be 679 the same as was allocated for the federal year ending 680 September 30, 2005.

SECTION 25. The Executive Director of the Department of 681 682 Mental Health is hereby authorized to transfer and receive into the Central Office accounts of the Department of Mental Health 683 684 certain funds which originated from the various Department of 685 Mental Health facilities as transfers to the Department of Finance and Administration - Bureau of Building and Real Property 686 687 Management for building/renovation/repair for certain projects 688 that have not been obligated by the Bureau of Building and Real 689 Property Management for the purpose for which the funds were Said funds are currently held in a Department of 690 transferred. 691 Finance and Administration account and may be held in Fund 3391. The Executive Director is further provided authority to transfer 692 693 those funds from the Central Office to any other Department of 694 Mental Health facility in any amount at his discretion.

695 SECTION 26. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 696 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 697 698 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 699 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 700 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 701 SECTION 27. This act shall take effect and be in force from 702 and after July 1, 2005.
