## SENATE BILL NO. 3116

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOEL EDWARD GREGG OF WEBSTER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Joel Edward Gregg of Webster County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction of the crime of timber larceny, in 1980, in Webster
- 8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve three (3)
- 9 years in the custody of the Department of Corrections. His
- 10 sentence was suspended and he was not placed on probation. Since
- 11 that time, he has conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 12 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 14 and after its passage.
