COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 3124

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 1001, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1996, 1 2 AS AMENDED, TO AUTHORIZE THE DESOTO COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS 3 BUREAU TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION TO DISCUSS EVENTS THAT MAY BE HELD AT THE CIVIC CENTER IN DESOTO COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AND THE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS FOR SUCH EVENTS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DESOTO 4 5 б COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU TO ACCEPT LOANS FROM ANY 7 SOURCE UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS IT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE; 8 TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DESOTO COUNTY TO MAKE LOANS TO THE DESOTO COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU UPON 9 10 SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE BOARD AND THE BUREAU MAY AGREE; 11 TO AUTHORIZE THE DESOTO COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS TO REPAY TO DESOTO COUNTY ANY SUMS PROVIDED 12 TO THE BUREAU BY THE COUNTY PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 2005, UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DESOTO COUNTY 13 14 AND THE BUREAU MAY AGREE; TO REVISE THE REPEAL DATE OF THE TAX 15 16 IMPOSED BY THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 1001, Local and Private Laws of 1996, as amended by Chapter 967, Local and Private Laws of 1998, as amended by Chapter 979, Local and Private Laws of 2001, is amended as follows:

22 Section 1. The DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau 23 consisting of seven (7) members shall be appointed, qualify and take office within thirty (30) days after the effective date of 24 25 this act. The initial appointments to the bureau shall be for the following terms: Five (5) members of the bureau shall be 26 27 appointed by the DeSoto County Board of Supervisors, with one (1) member appointed by the District 1 supervisor for a term of two 28 29 (2) years, one (1) member appointed by the District 2 supervisor 30 for a term of three (3) years, one (1) member appointed by the District 3 supervisor for a term of three (3) years, one (1) 31 32 member appointed by the District 4 supervisor for a term of four (4) years, and one (1) member appointed by the District 5 33 supervisor for a term of four (4) years; in addition, the DeSoto 34 *SS01/R1284CS* S. 35 County Board of Supervisors shall appoint two (2) additional 36 members who are also members of the DeSoto County Economic Development Council, with one (1) member appointed by the board of 37 38 supervisors for a term of two (2) years and one (1) member 39 appointed for a term of four (4) years. All succeeding 40 appointments shall be for a term of four (4) years from the date of expiration of the initial appointment, and all members of such 41 bureau shall hold office for a term of four (4) years from and 42 after the date of the commencement of their terms of office for 43 which their appointment was made and until their successor or 44 45 successors shall be appointed and qualify.

Any member of the bureau may be disqualified and removed from office for any one (1) of the following reasons:

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(a) Conviction of a felony;

49 (b) Failure to attend three (3) consecutive meetings50 without just cause.

51 If a member of the bureau is removed for one (1) of the above 52 reasons, the vacancy shall be filled in the manner prescribed in 53 this section.

54 Vacancies which occur shall be filled in the same manner as 55 the original appointments and shall be made for the unexpired 56 term.

57 Section 2. Before entering upon the duties of the office, each appointed member of the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors 58 59 Bureau shall enter into and give bond to be approved by the Secretary of State of the State of Mississippi in the sum of 60 61 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties. Such bond shall be payable to 62 the State of Mississippi; and in the event of a breach thereof, 63 suit may be brought by the State of Mississippi for the benefit of 64 65 the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau.

66 Section 3. When the members of the DeSoto County Convention 67 and Visitors Bureau shall have been appointed and qualified as set S. B. No. 3124 *SSO1/R1284CS* 05/SS01/R1284CS PAGE 2

forth herein, they shall meet at quarters provided for them by 68 69 DeSoto County after giving not less than ten (10) days' notice of 70 the time and place of such meeting by registered mail, postage 71 prepaid, directed to each appointed member of such bureau at his 72 regular address given to the Secretary of State at the time of his 73 qualification and posting bond. At such meeting a quorum shall be 74 four (4) members, and a majority of those members attending shall 75 elect a president and secretary, both of whom shall be members of 76 the bureau, and shall adopt such rules and regulations as may 77 govern the time and place for holding subsequent meetings, regular 78 and special, and other rules and regulations not inconsistent with 79 the provisions of this act.

The bureau is further authorized to employ personnel and to obtain supplies, furnishings and other facilities and real property necessary to administer the affairs and duties of the bureau and to pay for same out of the revenue provided by this act.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 25-41-7, the bureau
may go into executive session to discuss events that may be held
at the civic center and the contractual agreements for such
events.

Section 4. (1) (a) The DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau shall have jurisdiction and authority over all matters relating to establishing, promoting and developing convention business, tourism and related matters within DeSoto County, Mississippi.

94 (b) The DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau 95 shall have the authority to accept loans from any source upon such 96 terms and conditions as the bureau considers appropriate. 97 (c) The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County shall 98 have the authority to make loans to the DeSoto County Convention 99 and Visitors Bureau upon such terms and conditions as the board 100 and the bureau may agree. *SS01/R1284CS* S. B. No. 3124

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101 (d) The DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau
102 may enter into agreements to repay to DeSoto County any sums
103 provided to the bureau by the county prior to January 1, 2005,
104 upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Supervisors of
105 DeSoto County and the bureau may agree.

106 The bureau is authorized to employ an executive (2)director; purchase, lease or sell real property; own, furnish, 107 equip and operate any and all facilities and equipment necessary 108 109 or useful in the promotion of the convention business and tourism; lease or sell the naming rights to the civic center in DeSoto 110 111 County, Mississippi, subject to the requirements of subsection (3) of this section; and receive and expend, subject to the provisions 112 113 of this act, revenues from any source.

In the leasing or selling of naming rights to the civic (3) 114 center, the bureau is authorized to enter into contracts for the 115 use of a commercial, corporate, business or private enterprise 116 name on the building, literature, letterhead or other item, as 117 118 contracted for, of the civic center, provided that the use of the civic center is limited to providing a place for conventions, 119 120 entertainment, athletic events and other civic events. Such a contract shall be for a term that complies with law. In the 121 122 discretion of the bureau, the term of the contract may extend beyond the terms of office of the members of the bureau. 123 The 124 contract shall provide compensation to the bureau that, in its 125 determination, is fair and adequate consideration in exchange for the benefits, name recognition, advertising, potential returns and 126 127 publicity to the private enterprise. Any such contract entered into before the effective date of this act is hereby ratified and 128 affirmed. The bureau may negotiate and enter into such a contract 129 for naming rights, and all incidental rights associated therewith, 130 131 in the same method as is authorized by law for procuring a 132 contract for professional services. 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134 building other than the civic center, regardless of whether it is 135 used for public meetings on occasion.

Section 5. (1) For the purpose of providing funds for the 136 137 purpose of acquiring property for the construction of a civic 138 center and the construction and the maintenance of such civic 139 center to promote convention business and tourism, there is hereby levied, assessed and shall be collected from every person in 140 141 DeSoto County engaging in or doing business as specified herein a tax which may be cited as a "convention tourist promotion tax," 142 which shall be in addition to all other taxes now imposed, as 143 144 hereinafter provided:

Such tax shall be an amount set by the board of supervisors but shall in no event exceed an amount equal to two percent (2%) of the gross proceeds of sales or gross income of restaurants and hotels and motels (including, but not limited to, sales of beer and alcoholic beverages).

150 The tax authorized in this section shall not apply to 151 restaurants not selling alcoholic beverages under an on-premises retailer's permit issued by the State Tax Commission and whose 152 153 gross proceeds of sales or gross income is less than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per calendar year based upon sales 154 155 or income for the preceding calendar year. For the purposes of 156 calculating gross proceeds of sales or gross income, the sales or income of all establishments owned, operated or controlled by the 157 158 same person, persons or corporations shall be aggregated.

Before the taxes authorized by this section shall be 159 (2) 160 imposed, the Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County shall enter upon its minutes a request for the levy of such tax from the 161 DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau and shall adopt a 162 163 resolution declaring the intention to levy the tax, setting forth 164 the amount of such tax and establishing that a referendum shall be 165 held on the question of levying such tax during the next general 166 election. Notice of such intention shall be published once a week *SS01/R1284CS* S. B. No. 3124 05/SS01/R1284CS PAGE 5

167 for at least three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published 168 or having a general circulation in the county, with the first 169 publication of such notice to be made not less than twenty-one 170 (21) days prior to the date fixed in the resolution and the last 171 publication to be made not more than seven (7) days prior to such 172 date. At the election, all qualified electors of the county may vote, and the ballots used in such election shall have printed 173 174 thereon a brief statement of the amount and purposes of the proposed tax levy and the words "FOR THE CIVIC CENTER AND TOURISM 175 TAX, " and "AGAINST THE CIVIC CENTER AND TOURISM TAX, " and the 176 177 voters shall vote by placing a cross (X) or check $(\sqrt{)}$ opposite their choice on the proposition. When the results of any such 178 179 election shall have been canvassed by the election commission of 180 the county and certified, the county may levy the tax if a majority of the qualified electors who vote in the election vote 181 182 in favor of the tax.

The proceeds of such taxes shall be placed into a separate fund apart from the county general fund and any other funds of the county, and shall be expended by the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau for the purposes of paying any start-up costs and operation costs of the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau and any indebtedness or lease payments or other

189 obligations, including, but not limited to, refunding

190 <u>indebtedness</u>, the county may incur for acquisition, construction 191 and maintenance of a civic center for the purposes of promoting 192 convention business and tourism.

(3) Persons liable for the taxes imposed herein shall add the amount of tax to the sales price or gross income, and in addition thereto shall collect, insofar as practicable, the amount of the tax due by him from the person receiving the services or goods at the time of payment therefor.

198 (4) Such taxes shall be collected by and paid to the State 199 Tax Commission on a form prescribed by the State Tax Commission, S. B. No. 3124 *SSO1/R1284CS* 05/SS01/R1284CS PAGE 6 in the same manner that state sales taxes are computed, collected and paid; and the full enforcement provisions and all other provisions of Chapter 65, Title 27, Mississippi Code of 1972, shall apply as necessary to the implementation and administration of this act.

(5) The proceeds of such taxes shall be paid to the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau on or before the fifteenth day of the month following the month in which collected.

(6) The proceeds of the tax shall be used to retire the indebtedness incurred for the purposes authorized in this section and, to the extent not needed for debt service as payments become due, the proceeds of the tax may be used to fund start-up costs and operation costs of the DeSoto County Convention and Visitors Bureau.

(7) The tax levy authorized by this act shall be repealed two (2) years after <u>any</u> indebtedness, including, <u>but not limited</u> <u>to, refunding indebtedness</u>, incurred pursuant to this section is retired.

218 Section 6. As used in this act, the following words shall 219 have the following meanings unless otherwise clearly indicated by 220 the context in which used:

(a) "Hotel" or "motel" shall mean and include a place of lodging that at any one (1) time will accommodate six (6) or more transient guests (guests who are accommodated for less than seven (7) days) and which are known to the trade as such.

(b) "Restaurant" shall mean and include all places where prepared food is sold through the use of facilities to accommodate twenty-five (25) or more persons, and includes hotel and motel dining rooms. "Restaurant" shall also include a cafe, cafeteria, lunch stand, or any other place of business where prepared food is sold whether for consumption upon the premises or not.

The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County, 233 Mississippi, shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by 234 the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a 235 veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the 236 United States District Court for the District of Columbia in 237 accordance with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 238 as amended and extended.

239 Section 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 240 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 241 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

242 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 243 and after its passage.
