- 12 WHEREAS, not reforming the system will require a 50 percent
- 13 tax increase on every working American or a 30 percent benefit
- 14 cut; and
- 15 WHEREAS, allowing younger workers to invest a portion of
- 16 their income in personal retirement accounts will allow them to
- 17 have a greater rate or return and retirement security; and
- 18 WHEREAS, allowing younger workers to invest a portion of
- 19 their income in personal retirement accounts will avoid any
- 20 benefits cut and/or tax increases:
