## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 529

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING JALIN  
2 WOOD, MISS MISSISSIPPI 2004.

3 WHEREAS, Waynesboro, Mississippi, is the proud home of Miss  
4 Jalin Wood, daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Arthur Wood, who was crowned  
5 Miss Mississippi 2004 after competing against thirty-nine other  
6 contestants in the Miss Mississippi Pageant held in Vicksburg; and

7 WHEREAS, serving as Miss Mississippi, Jalin appeared at  
8 numerous events across our state, promoting tourism and economic  
9 development, welcoming people from all over the world to  
10 Mississippi, and sharing her "southern hospitality" as an official  
11 ambassador for her home state; and

12 WHEREAS, an active and outgoing student, Jalin graduated as  
13 Salutatorian from Wayne Academy in 1999 and summa cum laude from  
14 Mississippi College in 2003, holding a bachelor of science degree  
15 in chemistry; and

16 WHEREAS, while at Mississippi College, Miss Wood was the  
17 chemistry honors leader, researching drugs with anti-HIV activity  
18 and presented her work at the American Chemical Society National  
19 Convention in New Orleans, as well as in Memphis and Atlanta; and

20 WHEREAS, having participated in Laguna and Nenamoosha social  
21 tribes, Miss Wood actively represented her fellow students at  
22 Mississippi College as a freshman senator, sophomore homecoming  
23 maid, Mississippi College cheerleader, member of Alpha Lambda  
24 Delta, Phi Lambda Upsilon, Alpha Chi, Mortar Board, Who's Who  
25 Among American Colleges and Universities, Student Alumni  
26 Association and as Treasurer of the American Chemical Society; and

27           WHEREAS, a champion quarter horse exhibitor, Jalin's beauty,  
28 poise and grace has been featured in several fashion magazines,  
29 including: *Cosmopolitan, Allure, Marie Claire, Lucky, In Style,*  
30 *Glamour* and *Seventeen*; and

31           WHEREAS, now as Miss Mississippi, Jalin, who founded  
32 R.E.S.P.E.C.T (Realizing that Every Situation Produces Eventual  
33 Consequences . . . Think), will continue her travels establishing  
34 chapters of Students Against Destructive Decisions and promoting  
35 her platform of empowering young people to make good choices; and

36           WHEREAS, as Mississippi's Miss Hospitality 2001, Miss Wood  
37 traveled throughout the state and country promoting Mississippi's  
38 tourism, industry and economic development; and

39           WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the  
40 dedication and outstanding presentation that this young  
41 Mississippian has made for her home state:

45 2004, for her dedicated and outstanding service as unofficial  
46 ambassador for our state during her reign, and extend to her and
