- 3 SUPPLY AND THE APPROPRIATE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR NATURAL GAS, PROMOTE 4 GREATER ENERGY EFFICIENCY, AND OPEN PROMISING NEW AREAS FOR
- 5 ENVIRONMENTALLY RESPONSIBLE NATURAL GAS PRODUCTION.
- 6 WHEREAS, the price of natural gas in the United States,
- 7 already the highest in the industrial world, has again spiked and
- 8 shows continued volatility; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the abnormally high natural gas prices have been a
- 10 \$111 Billion unanticipated burden on the economy of the United
- 11 States over the past 18 months; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the United States is over reliant on natural gas in
- 13 our national energy supply, creating a tremendous imbalance
- 14 between natural gas supply and demand; and
- WHEREAS, the manufacturers, farmers, small businesses, local
- 16 governments and retailers are struggling from skyrocketing natural
- 17 gas prices. Further, thousands of jobs in these industries are
- 18 threatened, since many of these businesses use natural gas as a
- 19 raw material as well as an energy supply; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the natural gas imbalance is not a free market
- 21 problem. The high price of natural gas is created by governmental
- 22 policies that increase demand for natural gas while impeding the
- 23 development of a greater supply by discouraging more exploration
- 24 and production. Since natural gas is domestically produced and
- 25 very hard to import, the United States cannot correct the
- 26 imbalance by the importation of natural gas; and
- 27 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi supports a sound, rational,
- 28 domestic energy policy:

29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF					
30	MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That					
31	the Legislature of the State of Mississippi hereby urges the					
32	United States Congress to enact legislation in the 109th Congress					
33	establishing a domestic energy policy that will ensure an adequate					
34	supply of natural gas and the appropriate infrastructure. Such					
35	energy policy should develop a concerted national effort to					
36	promote greater energy efficiency, and open promising new areas					
37	for environmentally responsible natural gas production.					
38	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be					
39	prepared and delivered to President George W. Bush, the President					
40	of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States					
41	House of Representatives, and each member of the Mississippi					
42	congressional delegation.
