SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 13

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MICHAEL "MICKEY" HARE OF BAY ST. 2 LOUIS, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS HEROIC ACTIONS ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 3 2004.

4 WHEREAS, Michael "Mickey" Hare works as a UPS driver out of the Gulfport office. The Noll family of Bay St. Louis expected a 5 Christmas package that particular Monday, November 29, 2004. 6 Gregory Noll left a note on the front door, asking the driver to 7 8 go to the kitchen door on the side of the house. His mother, 86-year-old Virginia Noll, was at home. She is not sure why, but 9 Virginia Noll unlocked the kitchen door before the UPS driver 10 showed up. She was in the kitchen when her hip snapped, 11 12 propelling her backward. She fell to the floor, striking her head 13 on the concrete cushioned only by linoleum. The phone was on the kitchen table. She tried to pull the tablecloth sideways, but 14 15 pulled it down instead. A baking dish filled with chocolate fudge 16 crashed to the floor. She reached an unbroken portion of the dish and propped it upside down beneath her bleeding head. She waited. 17 18 She prayed. She began to wonder, as the minutes turned into one hour and then two, if anyone would find her before she bled to 19 20 death. She prayed to God to send help; and

21 WHEREAS, just before noon, Mickey Hare drove up in his brown 22 UPS truck with the Nolls' Christmas package. He went straight to 23 the kitchen door. It appeared no one was home, so he called out 24 "UPS," put the package near the door and turned to leave. Then he 25 heard a woman's voice. He returned to the door. He asked if he 26 should come inside. The woman called out, "Yes." He found Mrs. 27 Noll crumpled on her side, surrounded by blood, chocolate and

glass. The family's Siberian husky, Chako, sat beside her. Right away, Mrs. Noll's strength impressed Hare. Hare called 911 and followed the emergency dispatcher's instructions to put pressure on her head wound. He waited with Mrs. Noll for help to arrive, then stayed with her until the ambulance pulled away; and

33 WHEREAS, the family and Mrs. Noll's doctor called UPS, where 34 he received congratulations and applause from co-workers. The 35 Noll family credits Hare with saving Virginia Noll's life. Hare 36 has visited Mrs. Noll at the nursing home where she is receiving 37 rehabilitation therapy for her hip; and

38 WHEREAS, "She said she had been praying and the Lord answered 39 her prayer," Hare said. "I told her I had been praying, too"; and 40 WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to recognize and thank 41 Michael Hare for his compassionate and heroic actions at the scene 42 of a near tragedy:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend Michael "Mickey" Hare of
Bay St. Louis, Mississippi, for his heroic rescue actions on
November 29, 2004, and extend to him the best wishes of the Senate
on his future endeavors.
